A formal diagnosis years later validated her intuition, and ignited a deep commitment to transforming the diagnostic journey for others. Jade's story of resilience doesn't end there. After a long and challenging fertility journey, she became a mother to identical twin girls – a milestone she credits to persistence, science, and hope.

Jade has been recognised for her expertise in endometriosis care in *How to Endo* by Bridget Hustwaite – Australian radio presenter, author, and leading advocate for endometriosis awareness. She has also featured on multiple podcasts, sharing insights on women's health and holistic approaches to care.

Jade's mission is simple: to ensure people feel seen, heard, and empowered with the knowledge and support they need, so no one has to face the long, painful road to diagnosis alone.
